Body Piercing/ Tongue Piercing Declaration and Home Care Advice

I give my authorisation to pierce my I have been given a full consultation which I fully understand. I have both read and understood the following information which is highly important in taking precaution to avoid infection of my piercing and rejection of my piercing treatment. By signing my signature on the Body Piercing release and disclaimer authorisation form, I truthfully declare the following:

- I am not under medical care or care of my doctor or have any condition which may prohibit me from having my body/tongue pierced.
- If I am under the care of a doctor, e.g. pregnant, I have sought the doctors permission before having my piercing performed
- I am not suffering from, epilepsy, diabetes, haemophiliac, Keloid scarring problems, dizziness and have not taken alcohol or any type of homeopathic or medical medication for 48 hours
- I have been given full after care both verbally in writing, which is also on the reverse of this declaration, all of which I fully understand
- I understand after care procedures vary depending in the area being pierced and the type of after acre used, I understand this and note there is a difference.
- Understand the possibility of infection may exist due to improper hygiene, metal sensitivity or other causes, however most id due tom a failure to follow carefully the recommended after acre procedure.
- I understand and accept the risk that body and tongue piercing have a higher risk of infection and rejection which may result in the long-term permanent damage to the pierced area. I understand this and knowingly accept this riskSwimming, sun beds and the participation of athletic style activities understand that due to the nature of a tongue piercing, exposure of a newly pierced area to certain environments such as, eating, smoking and drinking, sexual contact may increase the likelihood of infection.

- I therefore will undertake the after care procedure. I understand if I do not follow the correct after care or use the proper after care advised for the treatment that I can in no way hold profiles responsible for any problems or infections that occur from the procedure.

After care procedure:

- ✓ Do not consume aspirin or medical / homeopathic medication for 72 hours after a piercing without checking with your doctor and body piercer first. Certain medications thin blood and slow down the blood clotting factor time which can cause a pierce to continue to bleed abnormally.
- ✓ Do not consume alcohol for 72 hours before or after a piercing
- ✓ You can carry on with your life as normal from 24 hours after having your piercing, just remember to protect your pierce and keep it clean and be sensible.
- ✓ Cleaning should start the evening of the day you have the piercing performed.
- ✓ Always clean your hands before starting to clean or handle your piercing
- ✓ When using cotton wool or cotton wool buds ensure that buds or disks are clean and stored a clean hygienic place
- ✓ Do not clean the area with Dettoll, TCP, Savlon, Surgical Spirit, Vaseline or antiseptic mouth wash
- ✓ Do not remove the piercing jewellery for the minimum of three months. Even after three months be careful to change quickly and do not leave the jewellery out as the pierce can still heal within minuets.
- ✓ When changing jewellery clean the jewellery thoroughly first, clean the piercing and clean your hands to stop any cross infection risks
- ✓ The pierce is classed as minor surgery, therefore for one year your pierce is till healing both internally as well as externally. The healing in a pierce under a year old is classed as an unhealed pierce and is limited to what jewellery can be used in it. Do **NOT** use jewellery for healed piercing or costume jewellery in a pierce under a year old or in an unhealed pierce.
- ✓ Daily check that the balls on the jewellery are on tight.
- ✓ Do not take your jewellery out as the pierce can heal within minuets
- ✓ Do not take the jewellery out when cleaning your pierce.
- ✓ Some blood, swelling and redness is normal with body piercing
- ✓ Large amounts of swelling with tongue piercing is normal, this is why a larger bar is placed through the tongue. To allow for swelling
- ✓ Iced drinks and cold compressed for tongue piercing is good for quickly reducing swelling
- ✓ **Body Pierce and Mouth Piercing, Stage One:** On exterior of the body piercing spray plenty of the after care solution on to the piercing, do not remove the jewellery and massage the after care in to the piercing with a clean, sterile cotton wool bud. Clean at least three times a day in this way. You can never be over hygienic so the more you clean the better.
- ✓ **Tongue Pierce and Mouth Piercing, Stage Two:** Dilute one cap full of the mouth wash solution in to a quarter of a cup of water and stir it up. Take a mouth full. Gargle with it firstly at the back of the throat (as this is mouth bacteria can come from), then swill

around tongue and teeth and lip area, then spit out. Do this until you have finished the glass of after care. Do this procedure when ever you eat, drink or smoke.

- ✓ **Body Pierce, Mouth & Tongue Pierce, Stage Three:** In our body we have white blood cells; these white blood cells help us to heal quickly. To boost up these white blood cells and to promote fast healing and reduce the possibility of infection Profiles seriously recommend our clients to take Zinc to boost up the body's healing and immunity. I capsule depending on the brand is the usual daily dosage; however as we want to boost your body's healing capacity it is recommended to take two a day. One in the morning and one at night after food with water. Finish the course. Profiles cells Zinc to help our customers obtain better healing and is available with the after care at a small extra charge.
- ✓ Be careful not to catch your pierce as a tier can cause the pierce to reject
- ✓ I understand my after care is an extra charge to my piercing.
